

# Dog Days Ale - Directions to Camp

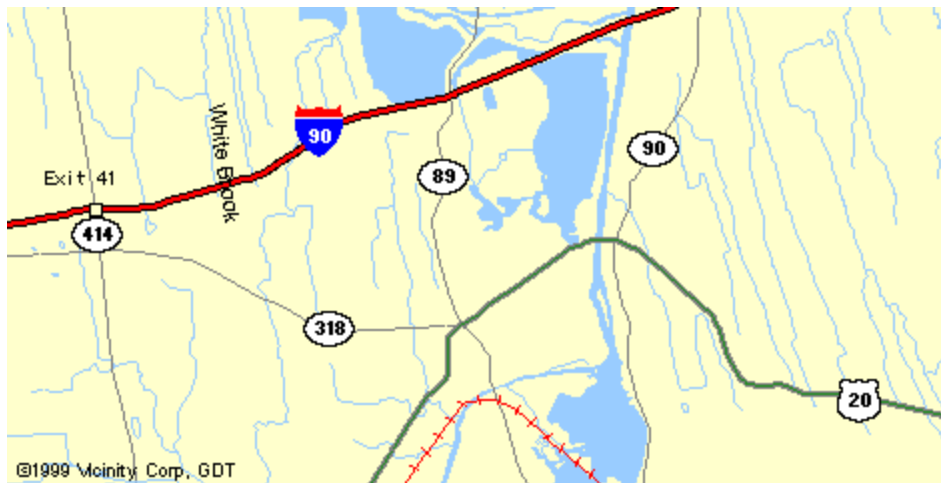
## Directions Via U.S. 20 From the East

The Ale is being held, as has been our wont, at Peter and Peggy Hoover's farm

Note: These directions start in Auburn, NY at the junction of U.S. 20 and Rt. 5. It's about 45 miles (75 minutes) to Peter's farm from here.

- 2.4 miles west of where U.S. 20 and Rt. 5. join in Auburn, you will pass the Finger Lakes Mall on the right. [Given as a odometer reference point.]
- Continue west on U.S. 20 and Rt. 5. for another 9.5 miles to Rt. 89 South. (You will see a traffic light where Rt. 90 crosses U.S. 20 two miles before. Rt. 89 will be the next light.)



- Turn left (south) onto Rt. 89 South and continue on it for 29.2 miles.
- About 1.2 miles after passing a parking area, look for a green sign on the right directing you to Trumansburg.

- Turn right onto this road, King Town Rd. (Co. Rd. 144), and follow it for 2.0 miles. It changes names at 1.2 miles to King St. and then merges at 1.7 miles with Lake St.



- Lake St ends at Rt. 96 (unmarked) in Trumansburg. Turn right onto Rt. 96 North and go through Trumansburg for 0.7 miles to Rt. 227.

- Turn left onto Rt. 227 South and drive 2.8 miles. (You will pass Boyd Hill Rd on the right at 2.1 miles.)
- You will see a sign for Schuyler County; slow down. The next road (sign is obscured by a tree until you're right on it) is Sitrine Rd; turn right and drive (Sirrenely) for 0.6 miles.
- You will see Rumsey Rd on the right. Turn right. Go 0.4 miles. Peter's farm is the second house on the left; big white farm house with a columned porch. Look for tents.
